### REGIONAL AND CONSTITUENCY CONSULTATIONS OF THE SIXTH NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN (NDP6) PROCESS

National Planning Commission has recently launched the NDP6 formulation processes in Windhoek under the theme: ***“Fostering Recovery, Inclusiveness and Resilience for Quality and Sustainable Development.”***

The purpose of the launch was to create awareness of the NDP 6 formulation with all stakeholders and public at large. After the launch, NPC must conduct regional consultations which aims to create a two-way process of dialogue between NPC and its stakeholders in setting the development agenda for the last phase of Vision 2030.

These wider consultations are expected to take place at the constituency and regional level to ensure optimum public participation. The whole process of developing the NDP6 will be done in two financial years, 2023/2024 – 2024/2025, to allow citizens to fully participate in this vital exercise as the Government of Namibia is committed to ensure that citizens are fully engaged in the preparation of the Sixth National Development Plan for inclusivity, transparency, and commitment.
